

**TOWN OF KILDARE  
ORDINANCE NO. 5(F)**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADDING TO  
TOWN OF KILDARE ORDINANCE NO. 5(D) REGULATING  
THE PLATTING OF LANDS AND ERECTION OF BUILDINGS AND  
STRUCTURES IN THE TOWN OF KILDARE, JUNEAU COUNTY**

The Town Board of the Town of Kildare, Juneau County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain that Ordinance 5(D) adopted November 12, 2003 is amended as follows:

Section 1

Section 8 is hereby revised as follows:

Delete the paragraph in its entirety and substitute the following paragraph:

“No permit shall be granted for the erection or placement of any structure closer than 10 feet to the boundary line of adjoining properties. No permit shall be granted for the erection or placement of any structure closer than 60 feet from the centerline of the public highway. No permit shall be granted unless the entire sewerage disposal system, including the septic tanks and drain fields for the use of said premises are at least 10 feet from the lot line of the applicant.”

Section 13 is hereby revised as follows:

Delete the last sentence and substitute the following:

“Any lot which has direct frontage on a public highway shall have a minimum frontage along said highway of 100 feet and a minimum setback of 60 feet from the centerline of the public highway.”

Section 15 is hereby revised as follows:

Delete the sentence beginning “Culverts (twelve inches minimum)...” and substitute the following:

“Culverts (minimum of 12-inch diameter by 30-foot long) are required in all cases, except where omission thereof is expressly permitted by the Town Board.”

Section 2

In all other respects, Ordinance No. 5(D) shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3

Should any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance be declared by the Court to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.

Section 4

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with any of these provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5

This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
