RESOLUTION 03-2017

OCCASIONAL-USE STRUCTURES &
PARKED RECREATIONAL VEHICLE REGULATIONS & FEES

WHEREAS the electors of the Town of Kildare, Juneau County Wisconsin, adopted village powers at an annual meeting of the electors on April 3, 1962; and

WHEREAS the Town Board of the town of Kildare, acting within the village powers granted by the electors, has the authority to establish certain fees under s.61.34 Wis. Stats.; and


WHEREAS the Town Clerk has received inquiries as to how many campers and/or hunting/vacation shacks for occasional-use may be placed on an undeveloped and/or non-resident Kildare Parcel; and


WHEREAS this topic is not currently addressed in the Kildare Land Use Ordinance;


THEREFORE the following regulations shall be adopted and enforced until such time that the Kildare Ordinance is amended or this Resolution is rescinded or revised:

- 1) A limit of two (2) recreational vehicles may be permanently parked for occasional use per parcel. A Registration application shall be completed and submitted to the Clerk with a \$50 fee for each. An approved registration placard will be issued to be placed in a window of said RV for viewing from the outside. Town supervisors have the right to inspect the RV for proper use, placement and waste disposal. Any RV determined to be derelict and non-habitable shall be removed within 60 days of written notice.
- 2) A limit of two (2) small (under 800 sq. ft.) hunting/vacation shacks may be placed for occasional use per parcel. A Building Permit application shall be completed and submitted to the Clerk with fees as required. An approved registration placard will be issued to be placed in a window of said structure for viewing from the outside. Town supervisors have the right to inspect for proper use, placement and waste disposal. Any structure determined to be derelict and non-habitable shall be removed within 60 days of written notice.
- 3) Any parcel that will have a recreational or occasional use structure is required to purchase a E-911 fire number for emergency purposes. Fee is \$75.
