AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 11

(Chapter 7 – Campgrounds)

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 11

RE: LICENSING, ACCESSORY STRUCTURES AND SEASONAL CABIN-TYPE STRUCTURES IN THE TOWN OF KILDARE, JUNEAU COUNTY, WISCONSIN

To provide direction, promote harmony in Licensed Campgrounds and Good Faith with the Town of Kildare, and for the health and safety of camping patrons, the following requirements are added to Kildare Ordinance No. 11, dated August 22, 1986.

All campgrounds are regulated by State of Wisconsin Administrative Code DHS 178.04 and licensed through the State; therefore, proof of a currently valid Wisconsin Campground license is required to obtain or renew a municipal campground permit each year at a fee set by the Town Board.

A municipal Building Permit must be approved before ANY structure is added within a campground;

State Building Codes (SPS 320-325) govern site-built or pre-fabricated CABIN-TYPE STRUCTURES; therefore:

- 1.) The municipality or contracted building inspector will enforce the above State Building Codes, in full compliance, regardless of size, components, and accessories added.
- 2.) Decks, porches, and/or steps serving as ingress/egress to any cabin structure, camper or park model will also abide by this code.

Exempted from this Ordinance is the permitting and inspection of a Camper, Trailer or Park Model which is factory assembled, framed with wheels and a hitch, and licensed with a current DOT plate.

Each campground owner/committee is required to stipulate and enforce a set of "by-laws" governing standards of placement, space and use by clients; the most recent copy to be submitted to the Town Clerk.

Failure to follow the above requirements will result in legal action and fines: Maximum \$200 and minimum \$25 per day, per offense, to be assessed to the campground owner and payable to Town of Kildare. Unpaid fines may be attached as Special Charges to Real Estate Property tax bill and may result in campground permit non-renewal.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, that this Amendment shall be in force and effective after its publication and passage as provided by law, and shall remain in effect until rescinded by further action of the Town Board.
