Ordinance to Extend Town Officer Terms In Response to Election Law Changes Ordinance No. 29

Whereas, the term of elected Town of Kildare officers have previously begun on the 2nd Wednesday in April;

Whereas town officers elected in April 2012 and thereafter will now have their terms of office commence no sooner than the 3rd Tuesday in April due to recent state election law changes;

Whereas this law change results in a week long "gap" between the end of the current terms of office for those town officers elected in 2011 and the start of the new terms of office for those officers elected in April 2013;

Whereas, 2011 Wis. Act 115 provides that a town board may enact an ordinance providing that the terms of any elective officers in the town who were elected to serve for terms expiring on the 2nd Tuesday in 2013 may be extended to the 3rd Tuesday in April in the same year in which the terms would otherwise have expired;

Therefore, be it hereby ordained by the Town Board of the Town of Kildare, Juneau, County, that the terms of elected town officers which shall expire on the 2nd Tuesday of April 2013 shall be extended until the 3rd Wednesday of April in the same year in which the terms would otherwise have expired.

This ordinance shall be effective upon publication or posting by the town clerk as required, pursuant to s. 60.80, Wis. Stat.
